Purple Mash is a brilliant online resource that the children currently use in Computing sessions at school. I will give all children (who are in school today) their log ins. Most children will know it already, but I will send a text to those at home today with it anyway. Type in 'Purple Mash' in the google browser, and once on the website, it will ask you to find our school - type in our postcode SK13 8EF.

On Purple Mash, there are lots of resources but ask children to click the 'To do' tab. Mrs Southworth and I have set a Times table activity, a postcard from New York as well as a fact file from USA/New York. These activities link in with our 'Road Trip to the USA' topic and we have already researched New York in class.

If possible, log on to **TT Rockstars** where the children have their tables already set (according to what we have been learning at school). I will keep changing the tables accordingly. The children should all know their log ins/have had laminated log in cards sent home.

Twinkl is an educational resource website that is offering free access to parents for home learning. It has fantastic resources, some need to be printed, but there are lots of resources to download/access through word. 1. How do I sign up for the free month?
