

Hello lovely Sunflower Class,



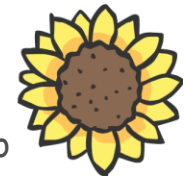
I hope you have had a lovely Easter and managed to get outside and enjoy this beautiful sunny weather. I hope the Easter bunny brought you lots of Easter treats.
