

Predatory Insects

Use the internet and books to find out about ferocious insect predators, such as assassin bugs, tiger beetles, dragonflies and antlions. Search for information about their habitats, favourite foods and how they catch their prey.

Produce a wanted poster of a favourite predatory insect using ICT or hand write it. Make sure your poster includes a picture and description of the predator, with phrases such as 'approach with extreme caution', 'dangerous', or 'reward offered'.

Note for parents: Encourage children to be discerning in the information they read, possibly finding secondary sources to validate their findings.
