

































Here are a few fun Easter activities for you to do together:

- Make an Easter card and post to someone you won't be able to see over Easter
- Design an Easter egg
- Have an Easter egg hunt!
- Treasure hunt! You could hide some 'treasure' for the player to find. First decide on the treasure and where you are going to hide it. Work backwards writing a series of clues/riddles that the player has to solve to find the treasure.
- Look for signs of spring in your garden and make a list
- Bug hunt! Look for bugs in the garden. Write a list and make a tally of the bugs you find. What is the most popular bug in your garden?
- Draw your favourite flower or bug in your garden
- Collect natural objects such as sticks and stones and make a picture. Look at the artist 'Andy Goldsworthy' for inspiration.
- Make a rabbit/chick mask or headband and sing an Easter song.
- Decorate a hardboiled egg. There are lots of designs and top tips online.

- Can you hop like a rabbit, walk like a chick? Make an animal pose (animal yoga)
- Play egg and spoon race or invent your own Easter themed game.
