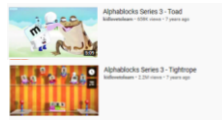


Challenge 1

Phonics

1. Watch the "igh" and "oa" episodes of Alphablocks on YouTube.



("igh" is called a trigraph because it has 3 letters but still only makes 1 sound.)

2. Label two buckets with the sounds "igh" and "oa" Make some word cards with the "igh" and "oa" sounds on paper. Your child should be able to remember some of the "igh" or "oa" words from watching the alphablocks episodes.

- Chose a word card, segment and blend the sounds to read the word.
 - Once they have read the word correctly they can screw up the paper card into a ball and throw it into either the "igh" or "oa" bucket.

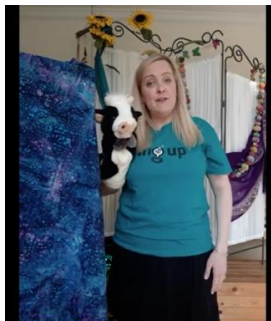
Alphabet Hunt

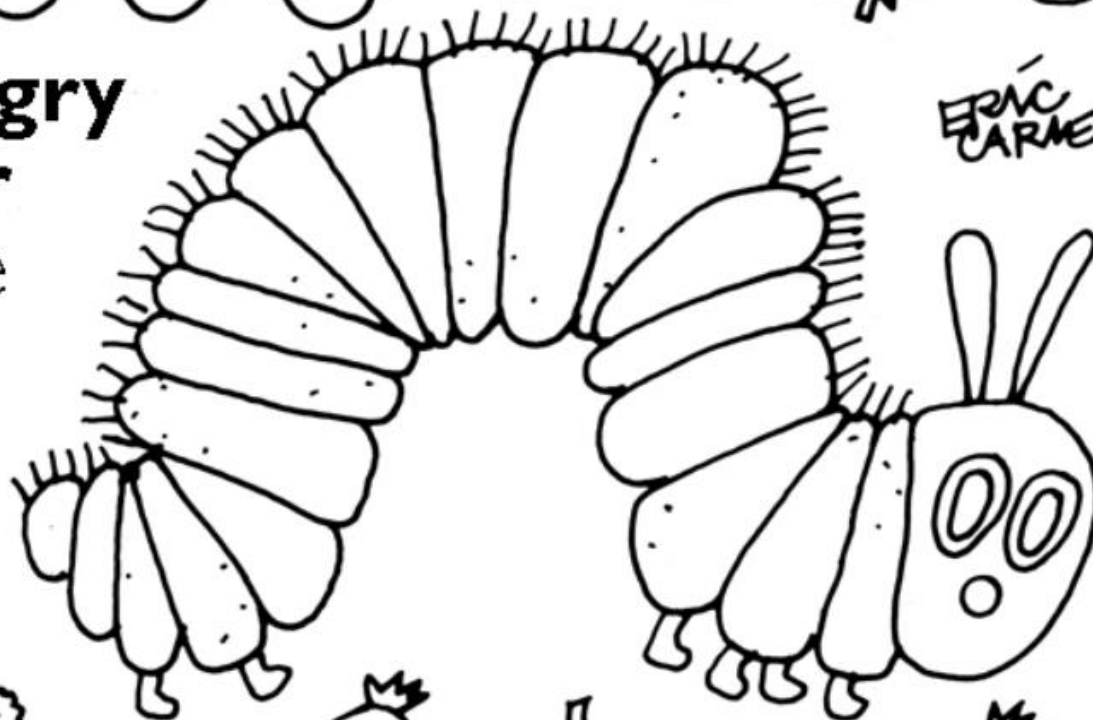

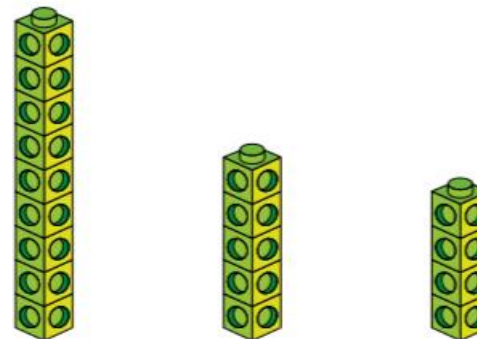
