<u>Maths</u>

2) Try the **2 to 12 times table board game**. Can be printed, followed on screen if needed or just challenge yourself to work through each question on the board - checking them afterwards with an adult!

<mark>Spelling</mark>

On Purple Mash, Mrs Southworth and I have set up **10 new spellings this week**. They are also available in a list of the class page. Look at them/revise.

Extra task - Try the **spelling sentence activity** or have a go at the spelling squiggle activity (the one we do in class).

- 1) Take a colour and hover it above a plain piece of paper.
- 2) Close your eyes and draw big swirls across the paper.
- 3) Open your eyes. Choose a spelling word from the list. In each gap write the same word over and over again in the same colour.
- 4) Now repeat until all the gaps are filled with all the words!
