Go to <https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/> Then click on the 'My class login'



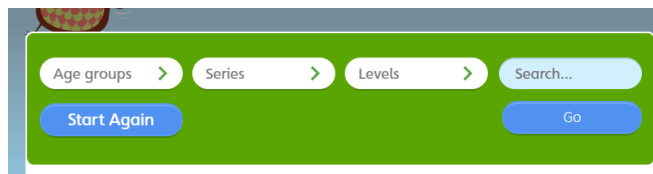
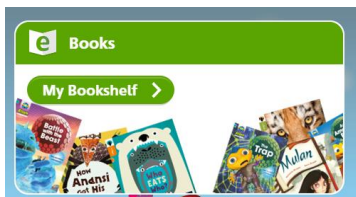
button at the top of the page Then enter the following log in details:



Username: sunflowersy1 Password: StJames (make sure you put a capital S and J as it is case sensitive).



Once you've entered it will come up with a 'My Bookshelf' button. Click on that and then you can select the age group, series, book band or search for a book and then choose the book you'd like to read. I'd suggest trying to read the next book band now, obviously if your child struggles with this new level go back and continue practising their current level. On the drop down menu of 'Levels' select 'Book bands' and select whatever colour follows your child's current colour.
