# THE WHITE HOUSE

- Home of the President
- It has 132 rooms, including 35 bathrooms
- Comes with a garage attached to it
- The East Wing has an underground protection bunker



# MOUNT RUSHMORE

- Found in South Dakota, USA
- The carving took 14 years
- Over 400 workers worked on the sculpture
- The whole project cost US \$989,992.32





# GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE

- Construction began in 1933
- The colour is called 'International Orange'
- It weighs 887,000 tons
- It has been closed due to weather 3 times



# EMPIRE STATE BUILDING

- Around 3,400 workers built this
- Five workers died during construction
- There are 6,514 windows in the building
- The lightning rod at the top is struck around  
23 times every year



# STATUE OF LIBERTY

- Built in France, transported in crates
- The official name is 'Liberty Enlightening the World'
- It is located on Liberty Island, New York
- Replicas can be found in Paris and Las Vegas





# BROOKLYN BRIDGE

- It took 14 years and 600 workers
- It connects Manhattan and Brooklyn
- Over 100,000 cars use it every day
- In 1884, 21 circus elephants crossed the bridge



# WASHINGTON MEMORIAL

- In 1885 when it was finished it was the world's tallest building
- It is 555 feet 5 inches tall
- In the 1850's it was used as a cattle pen, as it lay unfinished





# LIBERTY BELL

- There is a Bible verse written on the bell
- No one knows when the crack first appeared on the bell
- The bell is located in Philadelphia, USA
- In 1777 it was removed and hidden in a church



# HOOVER DAM

- The Hoover Dam is 726 feet tall
- 20,000 cars drive across it each day
- It was built between 1931-1936
- The Dam is 30 miles southeast of Las Vegas





# GRAND CANYON

- In the US State of Arizona
- One of the seven wonders of the world
- 1800 metres deep at it's deepest point
- You would need a permit to camp here





# GATEWAY ARCH

- It is as wide as it is tall - 630 feet
- The arch was complete in 1965
- There are 1,076 steps to the top
- It is found in St. Louis, Missouri, USA
