

royal starfish

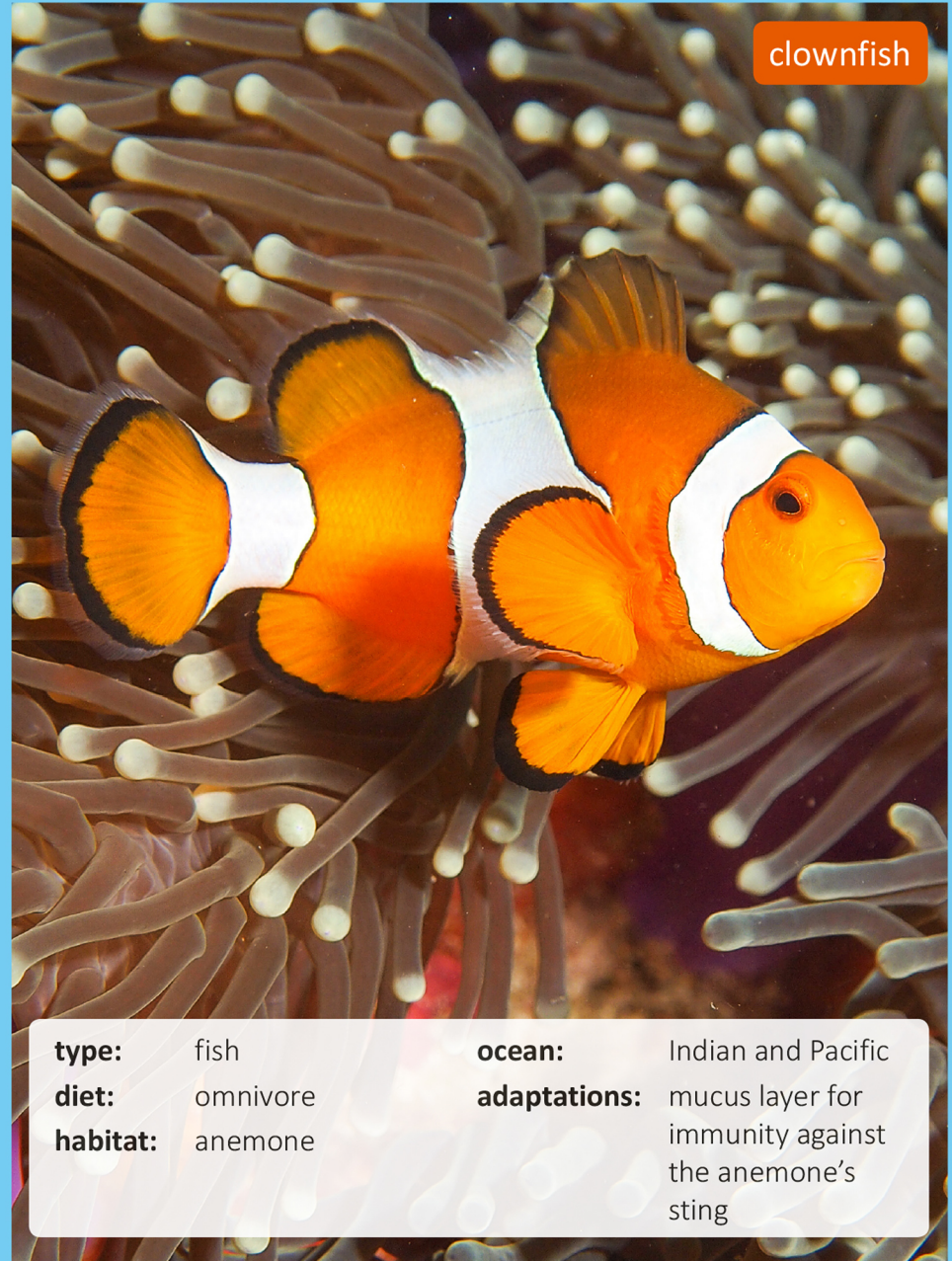

green sea turtle



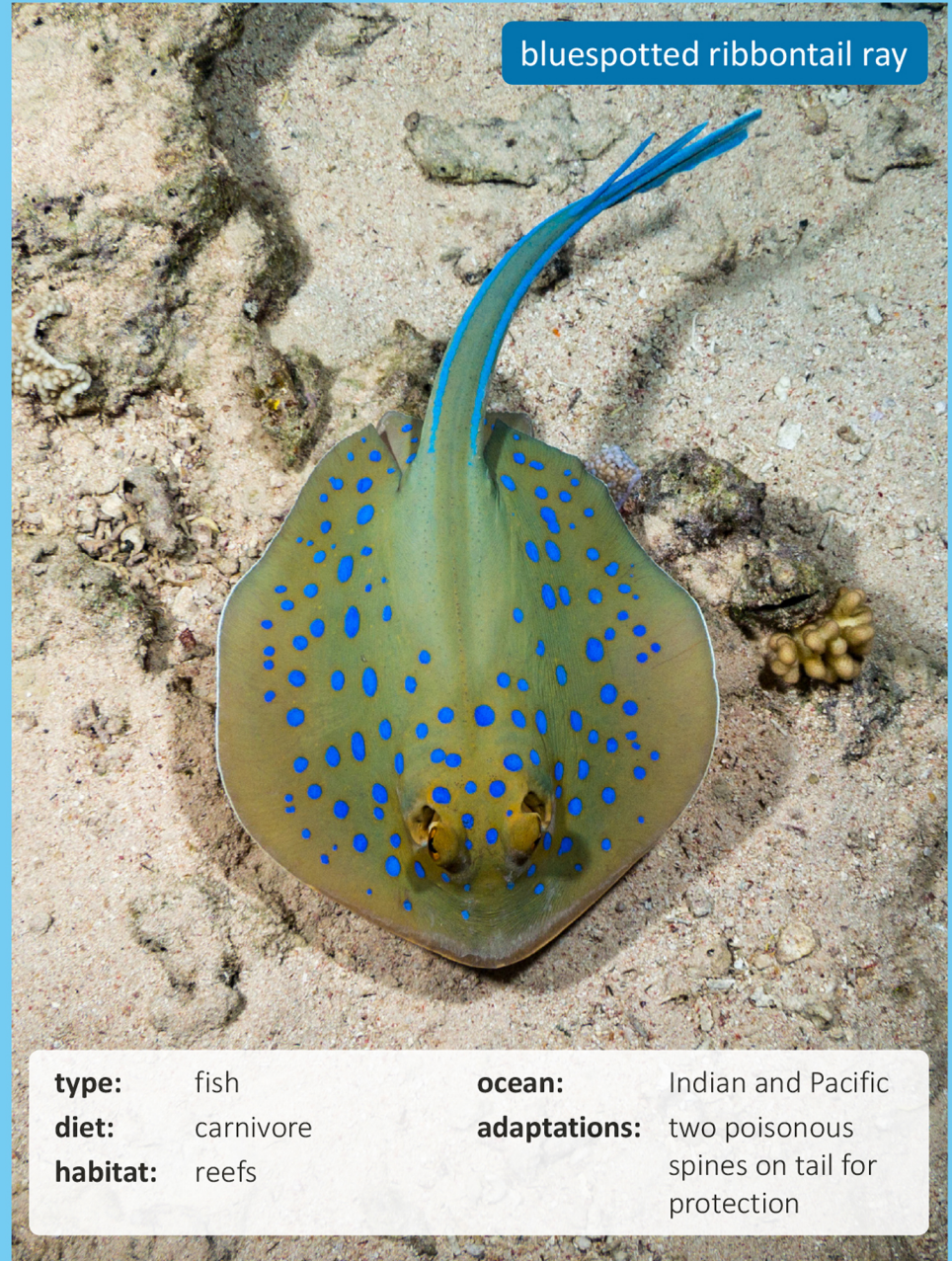

bluespotted ribbontail ray

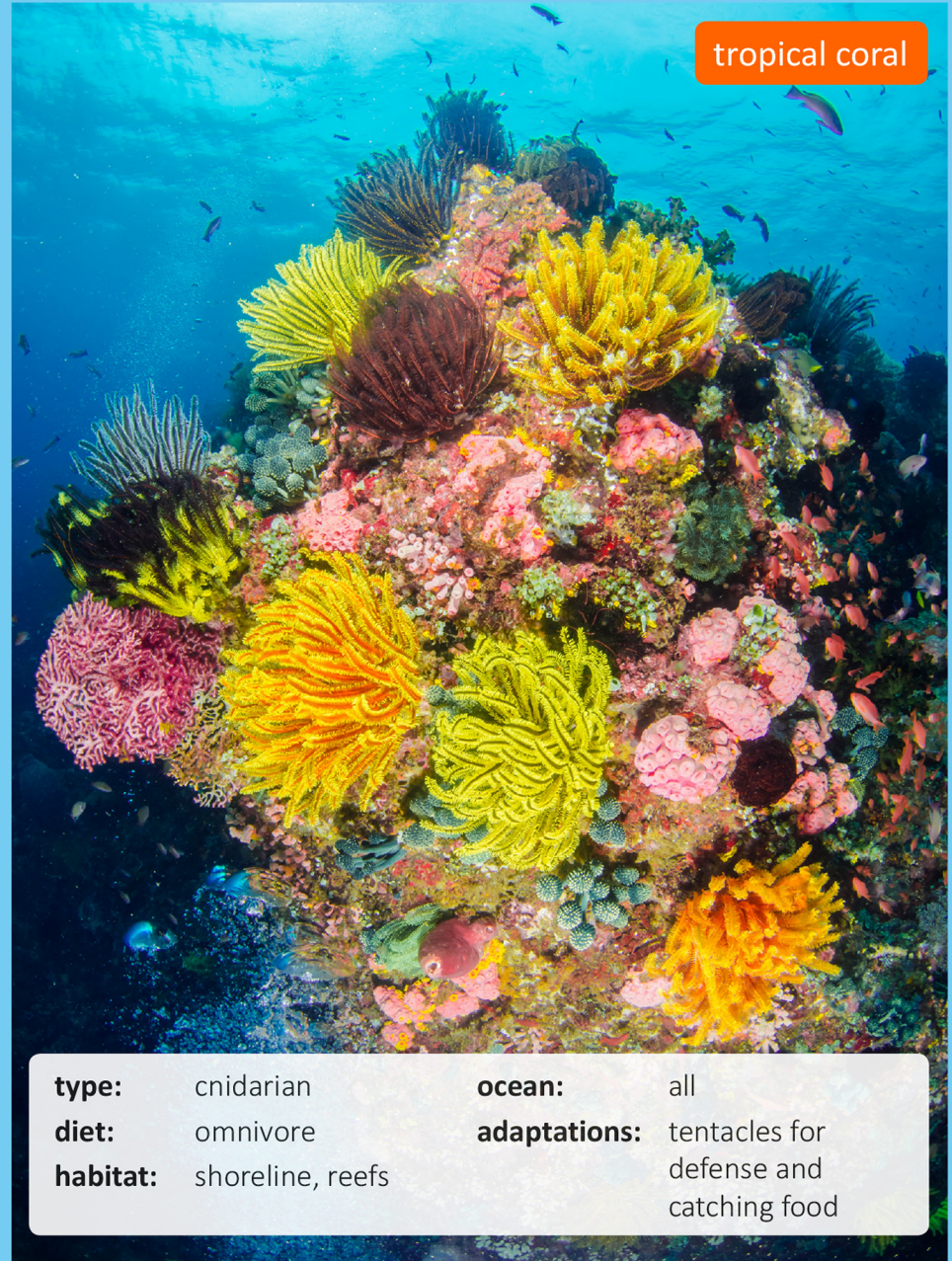

porkfish

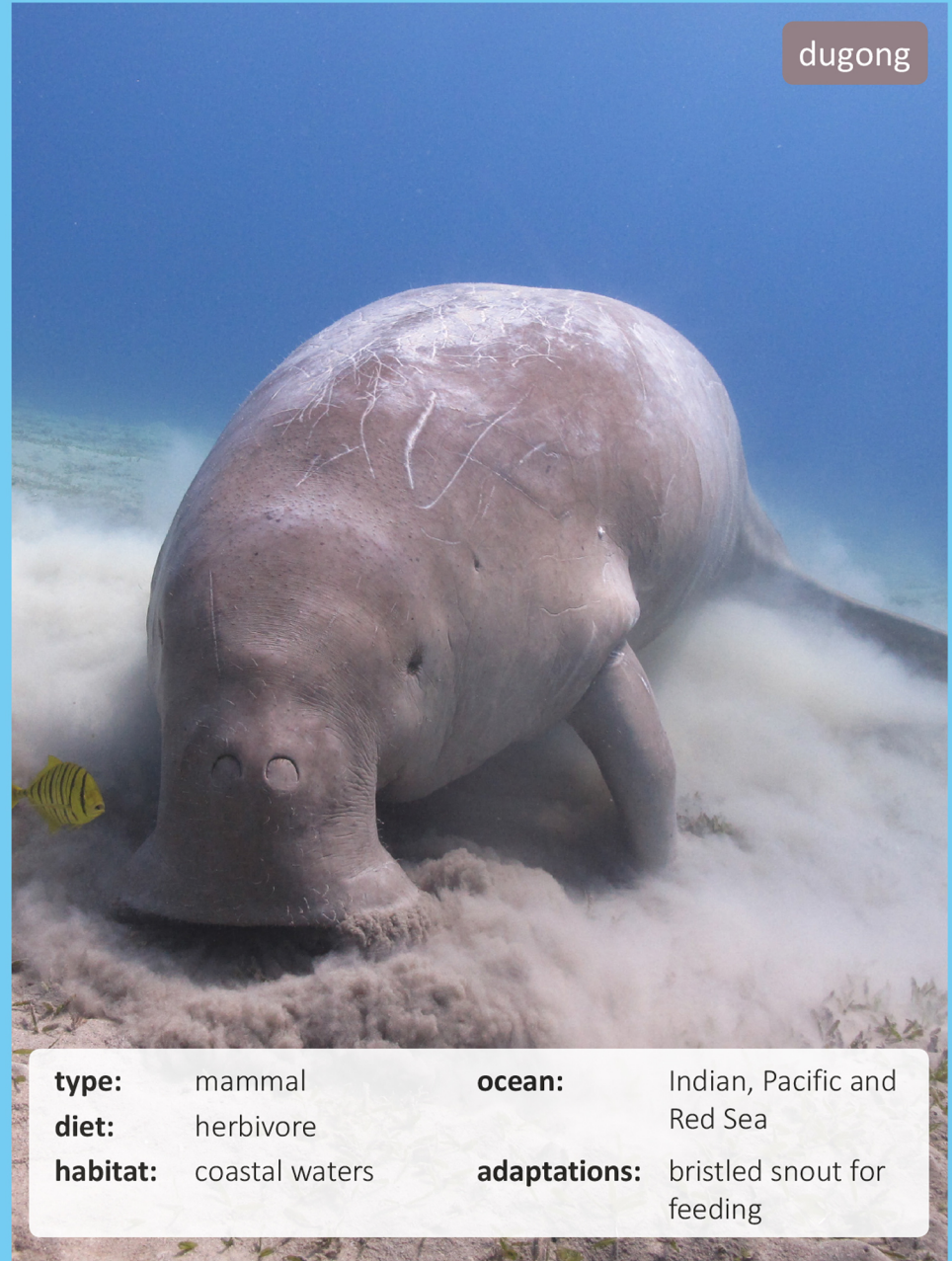
