



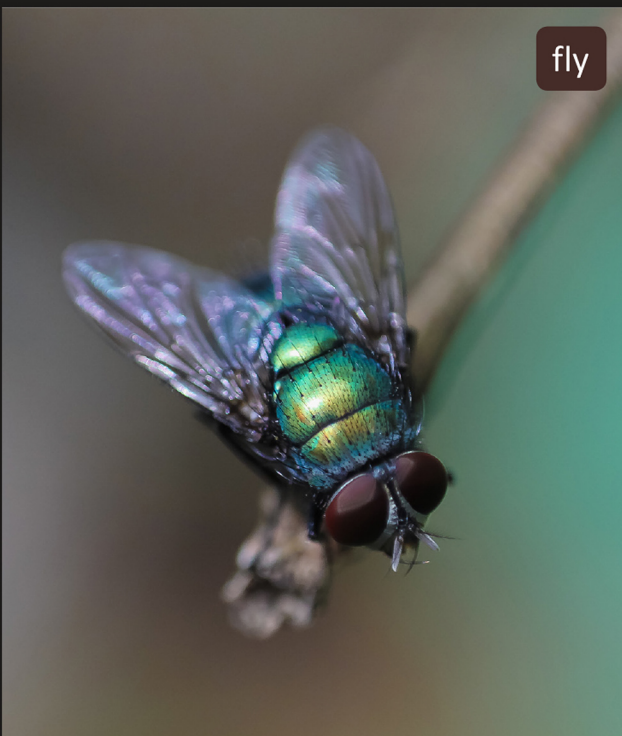
frog

Lots of animals try to eat me, including grass snakes, herons and otters. I eat a variety of insects such as grasshoppers, butterflies and flies that I catch with my sticky tongue.



grasshopper

Frogs try to catch me with their sticky tongues so they can eat me. My favourite foods are crops, such as barley and wheat.



fly

Frogs try to eat me, although I can often fly away. I eat a variety of different foods, but I really like rotten vegetables.



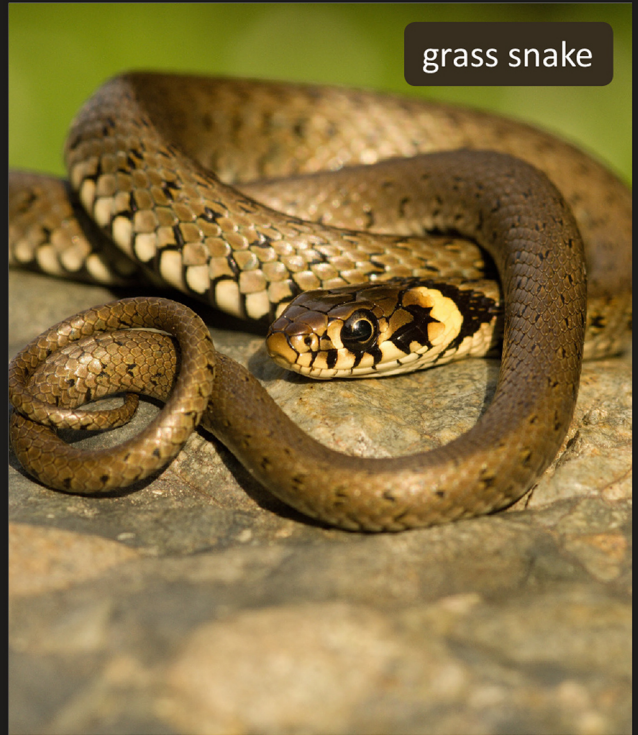
otter

I am often an apex predator, which means that other animals don't usually eat me. I eat lots of different creatures, such as frogs, birds and small mammals.



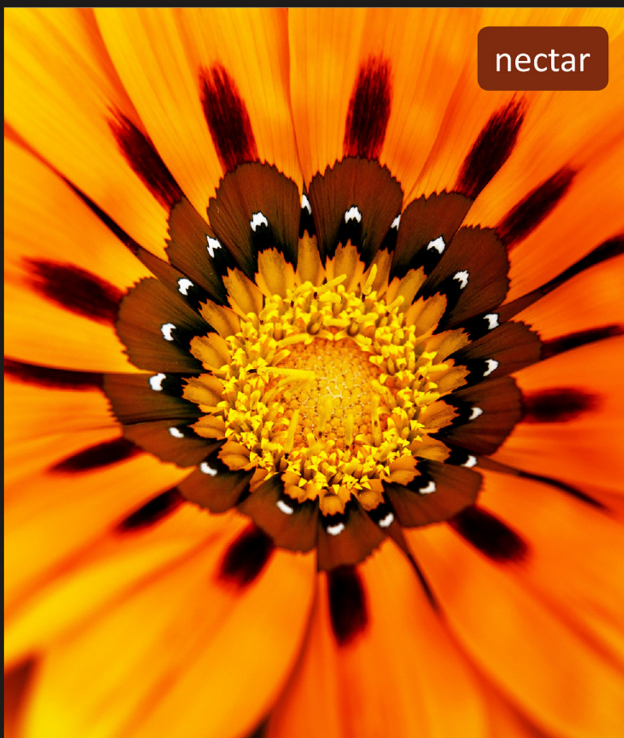
wheat

I am a producer, which means that I use sunlight to make my own food. Insects such as grasshoppers like to eat me.



grass snake

I hunt frogs from the long grass and also eat other amphibians, small mammals and young birds.



nectar

I am a sugary liquid inside flowers that nourishes insects such as butterflies. I am also collected by bees to make honey.



butterfly

I don't eat at all. I get my nourishment by settling on top of a flower and drinking the nectar.

I am an apex predator, which means no other creatures eat me. I eat many small creatures including frogs, fish and rodents.

Insects such as flies eat us, as well as larger animals, such as rats and badgers.
