Music	<p>Can you feel your heartbeat by touching your pulse points? If you need to, use: https://www.nhs.uk/common-health-questions/accidents-first-aid-and-treatments/how-do-i-check-my-pulse/ to help you. Use body percussion, such as stamping your feet or raising your arms, to replicate the lub-dub sound of your heartbeat for at least one minute. Does your pulse stay steady or fluctuate? Find out what 'pulse' means when referring to a piece of music. Write a sentence to explain how the human pulse and the pulse of a piece of music are similar.</p> <p>The pulse is the backbone of any piece of music and is most often counted in 1, 2, 3, 4. A pulse is a constant repeating note or beat (dum, dum, dum). How is it DIFFERENT from a rhythm?</p> <p><i>Can you find the heart rap sheet on our web page? Can you keep a steady pulse by clapping or stamping whilst reading the rap rhythmically?</i></p>
