Watch or read the story 'Katie in London'

Discuss the landmarks that Katie and her brother come across and discuss the adventure that she goes on. Also discuss whether the story is fiction/non-fiction, who is the author? Who is the main character? Etc.

Can you create a picture book, leaflet or poster displaying some of the sights of London? Try and label the pictures telling me what each thing is. E.g. 'Buckingham palace' or 'This is Buckingham palace'

Watch Go Jettters Series 2: 39 Wimbledon, England to learn all about one of worlds most famous tennis tournaments which is held at Wimbledon in London.

Can you research some famous tennis players? Look to see which players from the UK are famous and would normally play at Wimbledon? One famous one is Andy Murray, you could find out where he was born and how many competitions he has won.

Learn what the Great British flag looks like and colour in the template using the correct colours. (see template)
