

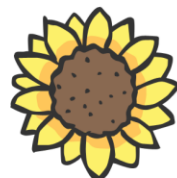
Hello again my super sunflowers,

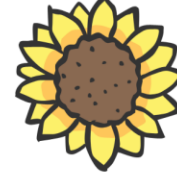

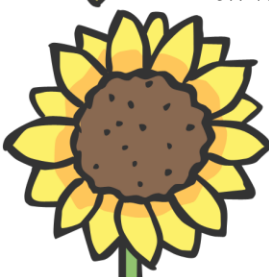
