Find out how a minibeast's appearance can help it avoid being eaten.

Note: Ladybirds, wasps and hornets have bright colours to warn other creatures that they might be dangerous. Ladybirds don't look harmful, but they secrete a yellow liquid that is toxic to some creatures. Minibeasts such as hoverflies and horntails have evolved to mimic these warning colours, but they are not dangerous. Other mimics include butterflies. Rotate an image of the peacock butterfly 180 degrees and it looks like an owl.
