rougheye rockfish

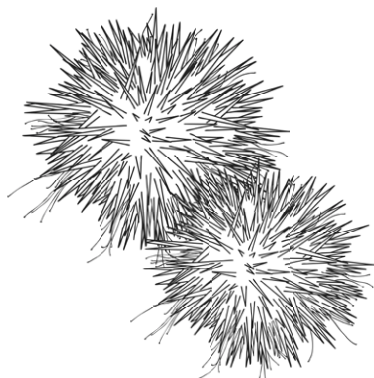
bowhead whale

koi fish

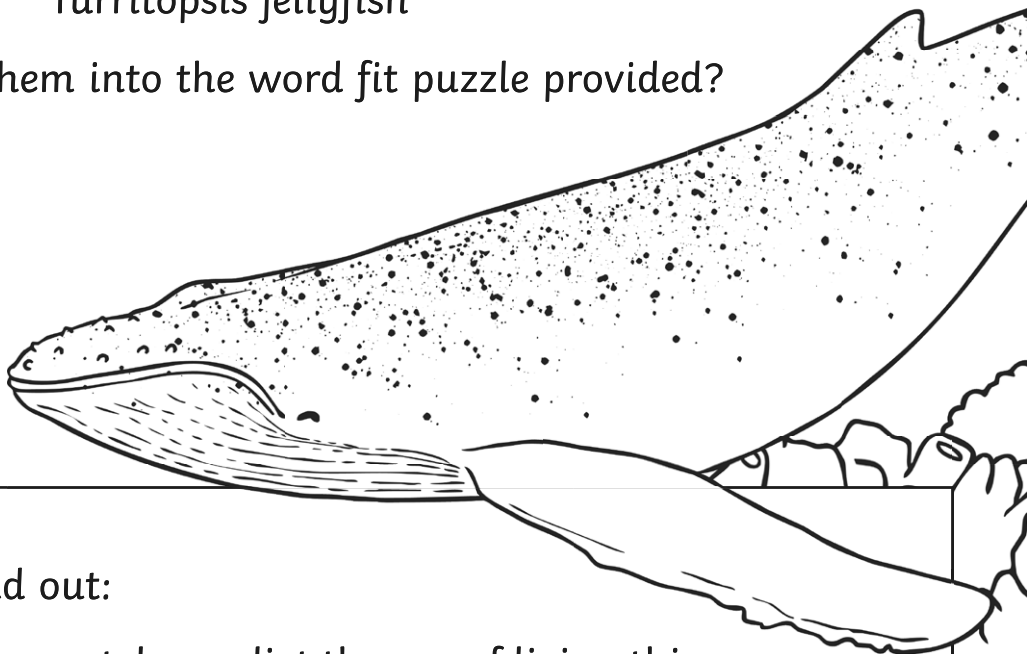
