Art

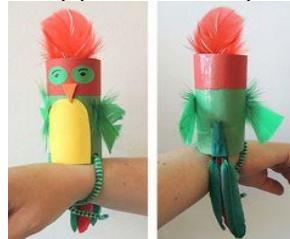
Make a pirate treasure box, you can use an egg box or another small box. Decorate with shiny paper and add you treasure.

Number Line Activity

How to make

- Write the numbers onto the "flowers"
- Glue the "flowers" onto the sticks
- Make holes in the cardboard roll for the sticks to fit (I made the holes 5cm apart)
- Write the numbers under the holes

Ways to use your number line.

- Order numbers 1-10
- Count forwards and backwards along the number line
- Remove some numbers for your child to work out which numbers are missing.

Stamp and Count.

Grab some play dough and use DUPLO bricks as stamps. Use index cards to create some quick number cards.

Adult Guidance

What Are We Learning?

We are learning how to count out up to six objects from a larger group of objects.

How to Set up the Challenge

- Place five blueberries into a bowl.
- Cut four grapes in half (lengthways) and place all eight grape segments into another bowl.
- Put ten raspberries into another bowl.
- Place a plate next to the bowls ready for your child to create the funny fruit face on.

How to Get Your Child Thinking

- How did you make sure you only used two blueberries for the eyes?
- Are you sure you only used three grapes for the nose? How could you check?
- You may also like to create your own funny fruit face and count out the different amounts of fruit incorrectly. For example, you could say more than one number name for each raspberry you put on the plate. You could say, "One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine," while putting just six raspberries on the plate. Then you could ask, "Do you think I used six raspberries for the mouth?"
