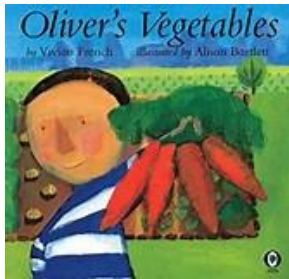




Dear Bluebell Class,
