



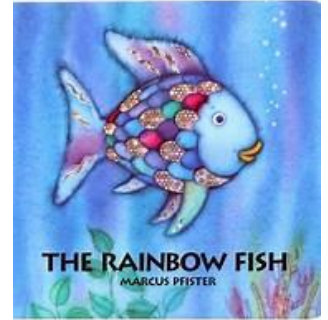
Dear Snowdrop Class,
