Continuing musical instrument tuition

Your child has been learning to play a musical instrument in school as part of the Wider Opportunities programme during this year. As we near the end of this programme, you may be curious about the options available to continue learning.

You may have seen some of the benefits that learning an instrument can provide throughout this year, and it is our aspiration for many of the pupils to continue learning next year. These lessons usually take place in-school and as small groups of between 3 and 6 pupils.

Which instrument?

It is usual for continuing lessons to be on the same instrument, however, there may be the opportunity to learn a different instrument if your child wishes to try something else.

Changing to a different instrument would depend on teacher availability and there being a viable group size.

How much would these lessons cost?

Tuition is offered at a heavily subsidised rate, enabling pupils to receive group lessons **FROM only £1.50 per lesson for a year** with a Music Partnership Accredited Teacher. Paired or individual lessons may also be available, but at an increased cost.

Where would I get an instrument from?

Children continuing to learn following a Wider Opportunities programme will be loaned an instrument for the next year of tuition free of Charge, whether on the same instrument or changing to a different instrument.

How do I arrange for continued tuition for my child?

Arranging continued tuition is quick and easy through our website. We just need a few details about you and your child, then a member of the Music Partnership team can coordinate the rest and be in touch with you so it's all arranged before the start of the next academic year.
