Extra Maths Challenge
Space addition and subtraction to 20

Can you play a game with balls/beanbags and buckets/boxes -
Line the boxes so they are getting further away from you.
Start by throwing the balls into the closest box. Each ball you get in is worth 2 points.
Find out your total by counting up in twos. Record your score.
Do the same for the further away box worth 5 points and the furthest away box worth 10 points.



Independent Activities

Role Play/Using Your Imagination
Get in your box/rocket and prepare for take-off - what do you need to take with you?
Pretend you are an astronaut floating about your room/space station - can you put on your space suit with slow exaggerated actions and step out onto a new planet?

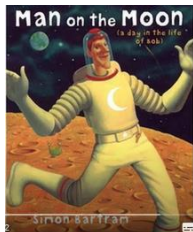

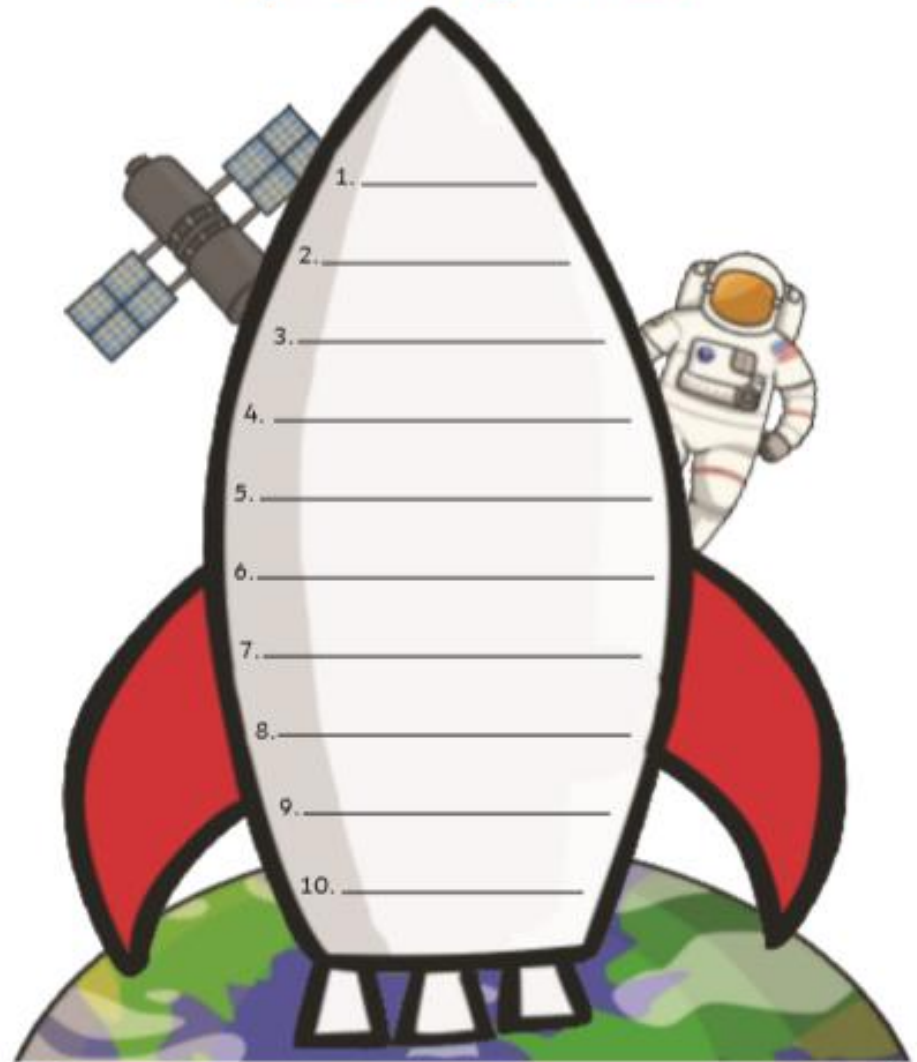
