<p>Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> On Tuesday the children will be being filmed singing Christmas songs alongside the F2 Nativity. We are very proud of how well the children have learnt the songs. 	<p>Communication and Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be listening to instructions and making Snowman biscuits. We will be reading the story of the week 'Pick a Pine Tree'. This is a lovely rhyming story about a family picking a tree, decorating it and admiring it with their family and friends. 	<p>Physical Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are practicing our name writing by writing our names inside our Christmas cards. The children will be developing their balance and coordination by walking along a masking tape Christmas tree. We will be drawing Christmas trees outside using chalk. 	
<p>Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Daily Phase 1 Phonic sessions. Eric the Elf will be setting the children a writing challenge – Can you draw a snowman! We will be mark making in salt using candy canes. We will be encouraging the children to make patterns and form letters using the canes. 	<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be continuing learning about shapes. Each week we focus on a new shape. We are going to focus on our counting skills again this week. We noticed some of the children needed more support counting out a number of objects. We will focus on numbers up to 5. We will also be ordering numbers to 10. 	<p>Understanding the World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children will be learning how to use our BeeBots. These are programmable robots that move in different directions. We will be making Christingles on Friday. The children will be learning about the Christian religion and what each part symbolises. 	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children will be making and painting Christmas Tree decorations and adding lots of glitter.
