Dear parents/guardians,

Firstly, our new topic is called 'Through the Ages'. We will learn about British prehistory from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement.

We are continuing to do P.E. outside on Tuesdays and Fridays, so please can your children come to school on those days in their kits and trainers.
