Book: Jack and the Beanstalk	Colour of the week: Green		
<p>Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are going to be recapping the school rules and ensuring they are embedded well and the children listen to and respect their teachers. – All week 	<p>Communication and Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Library books will be given out on Thursday. Please return library books on a TUESDAY. Reading the story of the week and discussing different endings. - Monday 	<p>Physical Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A beanstalk will be appearing in the classroom on Tuesday but there is a problem! It doesn't have any leaves! The children will be cutting out a leaf and then sticking it to the beanstalk. – Tuesday We will be making a beanstalk using green hoops and threading them onto a stick! This practices hand eye coordination. - Friday 	
<p>Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Daily Phase 1 Phonic sessions – I spy objects, drum outdoors, describe and find, teddy is lost in the jungle, cross the river, action songs - All week Phonics books are changed twice a week on a Monday and Friday. We have only given books out to a small number of children at the moment. 	<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Number of the week - Number 4 The giant will be setting us a challenge to find objects that are longer and shorter than his footprint. We will be taking our own shoe off and compare the sizes. – Monday The children will be measuring their friends footprints and seeing how many cubes long their foot is. Monday The children will be matching number to quantity this week. They will be choosing a numbered leaf and counting out the correct number of beans. – Thursday We will be challenging the older children by getting them to add two groups together. - Thursday 	<p>Understanding the World / Expressive Arts and Design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be starting to grow our own vegetables and learning what plants need to stay alive and grow. Monday We will be getting an exciting delivery of Magic Beans and the children will get to plant these beans. We will be planting them in a clear bag and attaching them to the window. The children will then be able to closely observe the bean growing and will get to see the roots. Wednesday Forest School in the wild area with Mrs Kennett – Thursday PM Science day! The whole school are having a Science day on Wednesday and the theme is Explosions! We will be experimenting with mento's and diet coke and hopefully creating an eruption! Wednesday We are also tying in our theme and we will with jelly beans!
