Topic: Getting to know you	Week commencing: 6.9.2021
Class book: Penguin in Peril	

English

This week we have been reading the story 'Penguin in Peril' by Helen Hancocks. We have created a new menu for the cinema in book featuring smelly food containing fish that the cats in the book would enjoy. We have sequencing the story, thought about and written some thought bubbles about how the Penguin in Peril might be feeling throughout the story (he was kidnapped from the zoo by some cunning cats wanting him to help them catch fish but luckily he escaped and made it back home). We have learned about time connectives and adjectives as well as discussed new words that we found in the story such as cunning, perilous, anxious. We have also been practising using capital letters to start our sentences and full stops to end them.

Other subjects

This week we have created self-portraits using a range of materials. We have done sunflower art by using tissue paper, pastels and card. We have worked on throwing and catching in PE.


Maths

This week we have been looking at counting forwards and backwards to 10,20 and 50. We have also been looking at finding the value of an amount by using 'tens frames', counters, coins and toys to represent the numbers. We have been practising forming our numbers correctly on whiteboards, with chalk on the playground and in our books. We have also been practising halving numbers by sharing them into two equal groups using the part part whole method.
