Re: Parent Partnership Newsletter: Autumn Term 1 2021

We hope you had an enjoyable summer and a big hello to all our new children and their families who are joining us this term! Unfortunately, we were unable to go ahead with the transition visits but rest assured we aim to make this transition process of settling into school as smooth as possible. Please do speak to us if you have any concerns and we will do our best to make this an enjoyable experience.

Our first topic is called "*Me and My Community*." This project supports children with settling into the new rules and routines of school and encourages them to make new friends and feel confident in their class. It teaches children about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school. This project also teaches children how they are unique and special, the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them.

What to bring in and leave at school

- A drawstring bag (no plastic bags for safety reasons) containing a spare change of clothes including underwear and socks. This will stay at school on your child's coat peg.

What to bring in every day

- A waterproof coat – everyday, clearly labelled with your child's name.
- A Book bag (this fits perfectly in your child's tray for any pictures home and, when your child is ready, a reading book). Please don't send in rucksacks, there is no room on pegs and they don't fit into their trays – thank you.
- A named water bottle containing water (not juice) – this will go home daily for washing and refilling. Everyone also has access to milk at the snack station – please do sign up for free milk <https://www.coolmilk.com/> or alternatively when your child reaches 5 you have the option to sign up and pay for milk.
- If your child is having a packed lunch – a lunch bag, clearly labelled with their name. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal.

Buttercup class will need to come into school wearing their PE kit every Wednesday. Mr Doyle will cover Miss Taylor's PPA on a Wednesday afternoon and teach the children PE and RE/PSHE.
