



Tulip class snapshot of the week

Topic: Potions	Week commencing: 06.09.21
Class book: Mr Pusskins	
<p>English</p> <p>This week our English work has been based on a fantastic picture book called Mr Pusskins by Sam Lloyd. We have loved discussing and writing about the main characters Mr. Pusskins and his owner Emily.</p>  <p>We have designed posters, written descriptions, diaries, postcards and letters!</p> <p>We have also been looking at adding 'ed' to verbs for the past tense.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>This week we have been looking at place value, looking at numbers to 100 and 1000.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you give your child a 3 or 4-digit number and ask them what the value of the number is.</p>  <p>e.g. 1345 – What is the value of the 3? 300.</p> <p>We have also started our TT Rockstars work identifying which times tables each of us need to work on. We have made up our practice booklets and have our home login details stuck into our homework books.</p>
<p>Other subjects</p> <p>The children have enjoyed beginning our 'Hopes and future' aspirations display this week and considered the importance of learning about other people's cultures and beliefs in R.E.</p> <p>We also started German this week – we looked at where it is in the world and started learning some key facts about Germany.</p>	<p>Any other information</p> <p>It's our WOW day on Monday!
