<p>Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> As part of Children's Mental Health Week we will be talking about what we are good at and what we enjoy doing? We will also be talking about the different emotions we feel. All week We will be making our own maps after reading the story Rosie's walk. The children will be encouraged to think imaginatively and make marks on paper. The children will be taking clipboards with them to make marks and have a go at writing the numerals. She has also very kindly made a fossil for every child. We will be breaking them open using hammers and seeing what's inside!
