

Personal, Social and Emotional

- We will be painting our own beanstalks and adding real leaves.
 Thursday
- Loose parts for the playdough area based around Jack and the beanstalk. The children can choose which resources they would like and make their own choices and extend ideas. All week

Literacy

 Phase 1 Phonic sessions – We have phonics sessions each day and will be starting with lots of singing and action rhymes! All week



Communication and Language

- The children will be getting a new library book to bring home. Thursday
- The story of the week is Jack and the Beanstalk.
- We will be playing the bean game! Wednesday
- We will be learning a new rhyme called 'Five Fat Peas'.
 Tuesday
- We will be talking about the different beans you can get and will be tasting, feeling and smelling them. Tuesday

Physical Development

- On Mondays and Wednesdays the children will be going over to the hall to play ring games, listening games and become active! The children will be taking their shoes and socks off which is a skill in itself and then learning how to move their bodies in different ways! Monday and Wednesday
- Threading leaves onto a skewer. Friday
- We will be exploring beans using tweezers and scoops. Tuesday

Maths

- Shape of the week Star! The children will be cutting out a star template and then decorating it.

 Monday
- We will be practising our counting skills by counting peas. We will be modelling accurate counting and encouraging the children to count out a specific number from a larger group. Tuesday

Understanding the World Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be planting beans and trying to grow our own beanstalk. The children will learn what a plant needs to grow. Wednesday
- We will be growing vegetables and fruits from seeds in our own veg patch.
