


A Snapshot of our week

<p>Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be reading the story 'Guess how much I love you' and talking about how much and why we love our Mummy's. All week 	<p>Communication and Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children will be getting a new library book to bring home. Thursday The story of the week is Rosie's Walk – Monday Listening games in the Hall – we will be playing with the parachute this week. Monday and Wednesday The Hedgehogs will be making their own story books! - Tuesday 		<p>Physical Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be developing our gross motor skills further this week and will be making our own obstacles courses and balancing along them. Friday Learning to hop, jump and stand on one leg – Friday Using scoops, scissors and mark making tools in the tuff spot. - Friday
<p>Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phase 1 Phonic sessions – We have phonics sessions each day and will be starting with lots of singing and action rhymes! All week We will practicing our name writing and mark making skills – Friday Mark making using chalk outside - Tuesday 	<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children will be counting out their own snack and will be practising their 1:1 counting skills. Thursday The Hedgehogs will be exploring 10 frames and finding different ways to make 10. Thursday Prepositions – we will be playing lots of games to practise using language such as next to, behind, over and under. Tuesday 	<p>Understanding the World Expressive Arts and Design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be making kites after reading the story Rosie's Walk and talking about the wind. Monday Our Mother's Day surprises! Shhhh– All week Mr Potato Head – the children will be experimenting with making different faces and adding different features. Tuesday 	<p>Things to know!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If possible please make sure that your child has shoes on that they can put on and fasten themselves. We try and encourage the children to be independent as much as possible and it can be tricky if they have laces. Thank you
