

Personal, Social and Emotional

 In the tuff spot this week we have cereal, spaghetti, water and making tea and coffee! All week

Literacy

 Phase 1 Phonic sessions – We have phonics sessions each day and will be starting with lots of singing and action rhymes! All week



Communication and Language

- The children will be getting a new library book to bring home.

 Thursday
- The story of the week is Handa's Surprise. Monday
- On Mondays and Wednesdays the children will be going over to the hall to play ring games, listening games and become active!
 The children will be taking their shoes and socks off which is a skill in itself and then learning how to move their bodies in different ways! Monday and Wednesday

Maths

- We will be exploring weight and the children will be weighing real food items and discussing which is heavier/lighter. We will be modelling lots of mathematical language to the children as they use the balance scales. Tuesday
- Jigsaws jigsaws are great for problem solving and improving special awareness. All week

Understanding the World Expressive Arts and Design

- The children will be tasting the fruits from the story and making fruit kebabs. They will be using the plastic knives to chop the fruit. Monday
- We will be painting and printing using fruit and vegetables. Tuesday
- The children will be exploring colour and mixing colours together.
 Wednesday

Physical Development

- The children will be threading pasta onto string to make pasta necklaces. We will be challenging some of the children to make a pattern with the colours too. Thursday
- The children have shown an interest in making binoculars so we are all going to make some on Friday. The children will then be using them when we go on a mini safari in our outdoor area. Friday
