Literacu


- Phase 1 Phonic sessions We have phonics sessions each day and will be starting with lots of singing and action rhymes! All week
- We will be making Pancake people and adding their features. We will be asking the children to give their person a name and challenging them to give them a name beginning with 'P'. Tuesday

Communication and Language


Growing carrot tops! Looking at the growth and talking about change.
