


A Snapshot of our week

<p>Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  	<p>Communication and Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children will be getting a new library book to bring home. Thursday The story of the week is Penguin goes on vacation Monday On Mondays and Wednesdays the children will be going over to the hall to play ring games, listening games and become active! The children will be taking their shoes and socks off which is a skill in itself and then learning how to move their bodies in different ways! <p>Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phase 1 Phonic sessions – We have phonics sessions each day and will be starting with lots of singing and action rhymes! All week The children sign themselves in in the mornings. They are doing very well with writing their names on the whiteboards and recognising their faces and name cards. Every day. We are going to be making salt dough squares using cookie cutters and then decorating them using felt tips. Monday Identifying numerals 1-10. Wednesday 	<p>Understanding the World Expressive Arts and Design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are going to finishing off painting sunflowers this week as we are going to be putting them in our best work books.
