It's been brilliant to work with you for your Wider Opportunities music lessons! You've made great progress and we hope you've really enjoyed it too.



This doesn't have to be the end of your musical journey....

It's easy to arrange to carry on instrument lessons. Just apply asap through the Derbyshire Music Hub website **www.derbyshiremusichub.org.uk/next** to sign up for lessons.

The lessons after Wider Opportunities are heavily financially subsidised by the Derbyshire Music Hub for one year, and **usually cost around £3.00 per pupil per lesson** if you carry straight on in a small group of two or three pupils. Individual lessons are also available but cost a little more.

There are more subsidies available for families in financial hardship to further reduce the cost of lessons. Find out more information at www.derbyshiremusichub.org.uk/next

It's free to keep the instrument you have played for Wider Opportunities and there is no hire charge!

Lessons take place in school once a week, delivered by an expert instrument teacher.

All children in the class have learnt either the violin, viola or cello this year. Most children continue on the same instrument, but it may be possible to change to another. You can switch to a different string instrument, and lessons are also available on woodwind (clarinet, flute, recorder) and brass (trumpet, horn, trombone) at your school.
