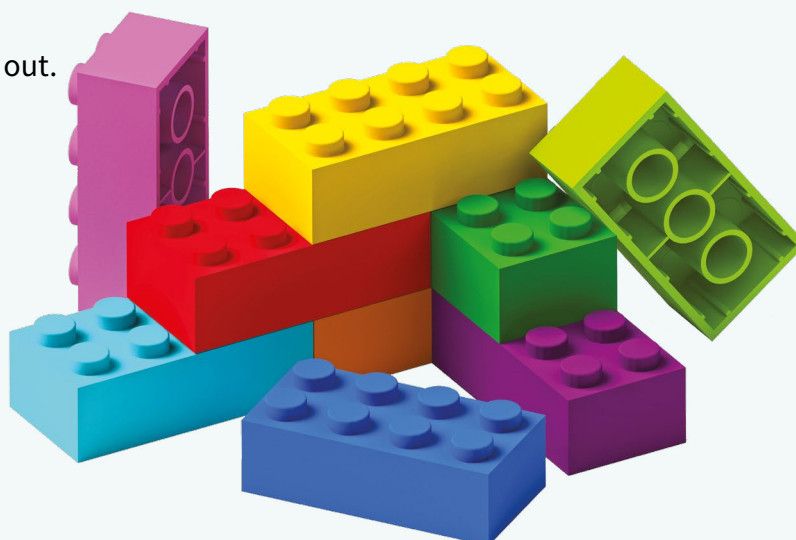
Task 5: ADVICE
