Social media

This message is to make parents aware of some of the issues we are seeing in school regarding social media. Most platforms, such as WhatsApp and Facebook have an age 13 requirement to have an account. If your child has an account, please monitor the account to ensure your child is safe while using it.

These are some of the examples we have been given by parents and pupils this term.

- Some pupils are up until 2pm and 3pm on social media and this could impact learning and mental health.
- Pupils have been reported as saying inappropriate things that they would not say in person. Once something is online, it stays there and cannot be permanently deleted. Some things could be reportable to the police.
- Pupils being encouraged to add people they do not know. This may be innocent but it could also be grooming.

Social media can be truly fantastic and have many positive applications. However, please monitor what your children are doing and give them the skills to use social media platforms safely. We did not have the same challenges growing up.
